4. The manuscript was created using the submission template with numbers and script in half-width characters.
5. The title page includes the following information:
 - 1) Article title, author names, affiliations in both English and Japanese
 - 2) Corresponding author's name, address, telephone number and email address
 - 3) The publication category (Original Article, Short Communication, Review Article, Practical Article)
6. A Japanese abstract is within 400 characters and an English abstract is within 250 words.
7. Up to 5 keywords in Japanese and English respectively are included.
8. The English abstract was reviewed before submission by a native English speaker in case the author is a non-native English speaker.
